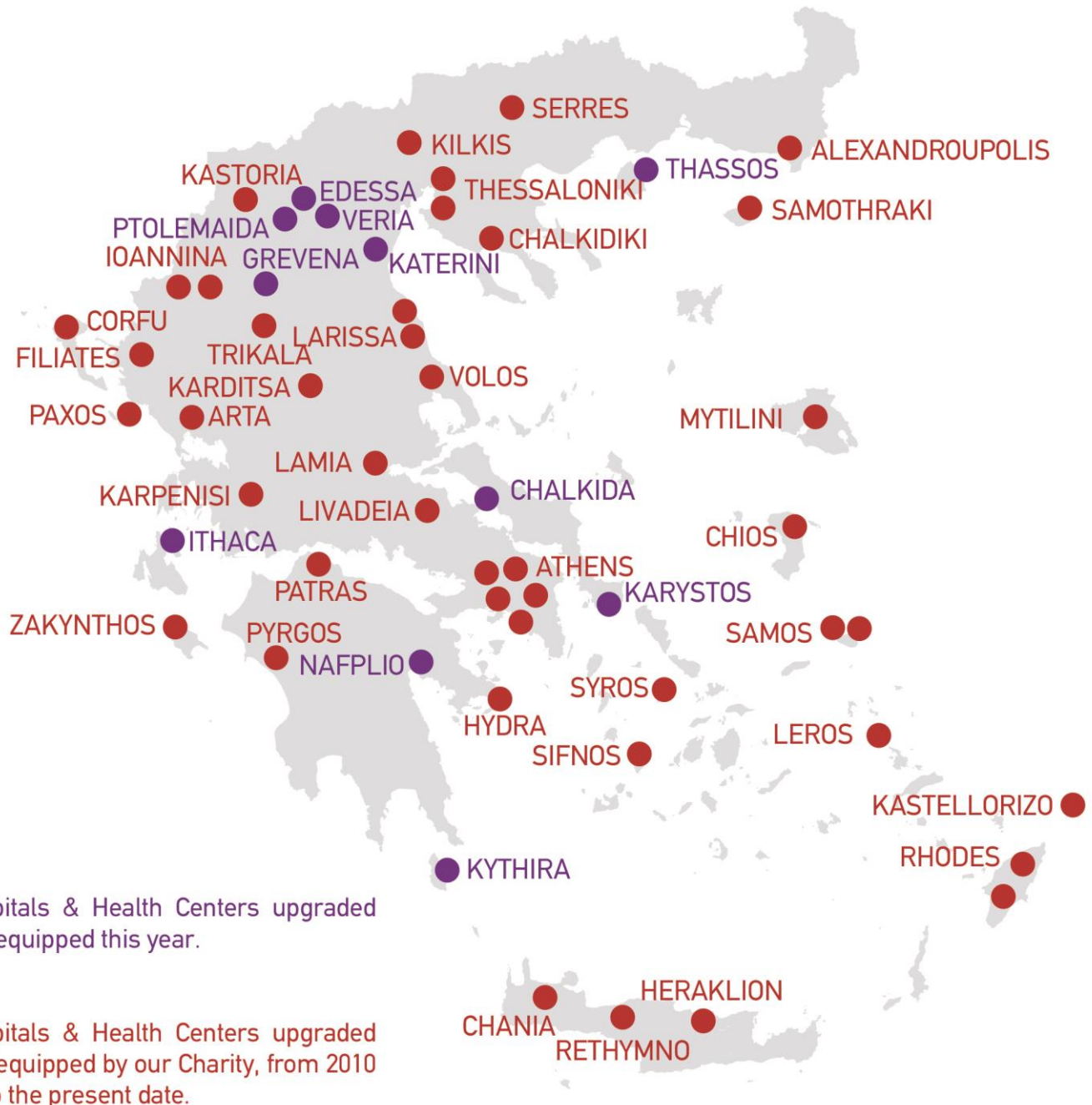

“Paediatric Emergency Ruler”: Scientific tool which is used for paediatric emergencies

(Cost: € 3.133,48)

In May 2019 the Charity “Pediatric Trauma Care”, with the generous donation of Mrs Maria Giannousi-Sofianopoulou, funded the “Paediatric Emergency Ruler”, a scientific tool which is used for paediatric emergencies at the level of primary care.

The “Paediatric Emergency Ruler” was translated for the first time into Greek by the Charity’s Scientific Advisor, Dr Aristoula Patsoura (MD, Director in “Pan. & Aglaia Kyriakou” Children’s Hospital, PICU), and Dr Konstantina Mitropoulou (MD, MSc Paediatric Intensivist, PICU in “Pan. & Aglaia Kyriakou” Children’s Hospital).

By measuring the child’s height, the “Paediatric Emergency Ruler” provides immediate information to doctors and nurses regarding the doses of urgent paediatric medications, as well as the size of the equipment needed to treat a severely injured child. Its lamination ensures its long-lasting and durable use in the trauma centers.

In total, 266 items were printed, which will be available free of charge to all Trauma Centers and Paediatric Departments of the hospitals and health centers in Greece that have been, or will be, equipped by "Pedtrauma".

MEDICAL SEMINARS A.P.L.S. & P.L.S. (Cost: € 14.362,58)

With the sponsorship of an anonymous benefactor, we funded:

- One A.P.L.S. (Advanced Paediatric Life Support) seminar, held in collaboration with A.P.L.S. Crete in Crete, and one A.P.L.S. seminar held in collaboration with A.P.L.S. HELLAS in Athens, were attended in total by 55 doctors (total value € 5.750).

- Two P.L.S. (Paediatric Life Support) seminars, which were held in collaboration with A.P.L.S. Crete in Crete, were attended by 46 doctors and nurses (total value € 2.300).

- In July and September 2019 Pedtrauma bought equipment to be used for the A.P.L.S. HELLAS medical seminars, as well as for the Postgraduate Program "Emergency and Intensive Care for children, adolescents and young people" of the University of Crete. Specifically, infant and toddler manikins, multi-trauma immobilizers, defibrillators and masks were purchased (cost € 6.312,58).

EDUCATION ON TRAUMA PREVENTION (Cost: € 18.000)

By introducing Trauma Prevention into schools the number and severity of accidents occurring can be reduced by up to 50%. For this reason, we continued the presentations and distribution of brochures to students, teachers and Parent Associations. To date we have spoken to 46.699 children and 3.090 teachers and parents.

“Alpha Bank” adopted the sponsorship of our Program on Paediatric Trauma Prevention for yet another year (with the amount of € 5.000) together with the “Friends of Pediatric Trauma Care” (with the amount of € 1.000). The remaining amount for the needs of the program (€ 6.000) was covered by the Charity. From 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2018 until 31<sup>st</sup> of October 2019 we held 41 presentations which were attended by 2.438 children and 33 parents.

Our brochures were distributed to Schools, Kindergardens and Parent Associations, in the greater Attika area, during the presentations. They were also distributed to many other Charities, Schools, Kindergardens and Hospitals throughout Greece.

During the course of the year we printed 20.000 brochures on “Safety at Home” (Sponsor: MYTILINEOS S.A), cost € 3.000, and 20.000 brochures on “Sports and Safety” (Sponsor: MYTILINEOS S.A), cost € 3.000.

“Pedtrauma” supported, for yet another year, the Charity “Aegean Team”, by offering brochures on Trauma Prevention in order to be distributed during their Winter Mission to Kythnos and Serifos, which took place 16<sup>th</sup> - 18<sup>th</sup> November.

OPERATING CHARITY COSTS

The Stavros Niarchos Foundation continued to support our work by sponsoring the salary of one of the Charity’s employees for the year 2019. This donation is invaluable to us, as it helps us cover part of our operating costs.

## EVENTS

On Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> of November 2018 a bazaar was held at Ktima Kokotou, for the fourth consecutive year. The bazaar was a great success, attracting many visitors! Young and old alike enjoyed the activities while shopping from the bazaar. During the bazaar, a lottery was held with many lovely prizes.

From November 2<sup>nd</sup> 2018 to November 4<sup>th</sup> 2018 the “No Finish Run” race took place in Thessaloniki, which supported our Charity for the first time. The money was given based on kilometers run by the participants, (walking or running, at any time of the day or night they wanted, as many times as they wanted, in whatever way and at whatever pace they wanted and for as long as they wanted) in the specially configured circular route on the beautiful New Beach (Nea Paralia) of Thessaloniki. Of the total amount collected, € 3.000 was donated to the Charity “Pediatric Trauma Care” in order to purchase equipment for the Paediatric Department of the “Ippocratio” General Hospital of Thessaloniki. The Cheque was given to us at a ceremony which was held at the "Macedonia Palace" Hotel, and was attended by the President of the Charity Mrs Natasha Clive-Vrecossis and Dr Despina Iordanidou, Paediatric Anaesthetist Consultant at the General Hospital of Thessaloniki “Ippokrateio” and member of the Charity’s scientific team.

In November 2018, for yet another year, the Jewellery store "VOURAKIS" created our New Year’s good luck charm for 2019, the sale of which helped our fund-raising efforts.

On Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> of December 2018, our Charity held a Christmas Bazaar at KARTLAND in Pallini.

On 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> December 2018 Pedtrauma was invited, for yet another year, to participate in the Christmas Bazaar held at the Headquarters of the Insurance Company “NN Hellas”.

The company “MEGA DISPOSABLES S.A.” and the “Hellenic Hypermarkets SKLAVENITIS S.A.” supported our Charity yet again, offering medical equipment to the Paidon Pentelis Children’s Hospital and the Paediatric Department of the General Hospital of Thessaloniki “G. Gennimatas – O Aghios Dimitrios”. The event lasted from 21<sup>st</sup> November to 4<sup>th</sup> December 2018 at all the “SKLAVENITIS” stores for the purchase of “Babyfino Sensitive” products.

Also, the company “MEGA DISPOSABLES S.A.” supported our Charity through a special event that took place during the Christmas period (December 15<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>) at “The Mall Athens”, helping us to provide medical equipment to the Paidon Pentelis Children’s Hospital.

“Pedtrauma” participated in the Bravo Dialogue 2018, which has been held for the last 9 years by the QualityNet Foundation, and develops an annual social dialogue on Sustainable Development based on initiatives implemented by Businesses, Local Government and the Civil Society. All organizations involved in the BRAVO Dialogue are “Ambassadors for Sustainable Development”, a philosophy that supports a sustainable future, and, together with their initiatives, contributes to the creation of future Greece.

Since December 2018, our Charity has been participating on the “MIA ORA” platform, (the first Greek information/awareness Platform, concerning solidarity and mobilization to create a better world for all) through which everyone can support Non-Profit Organizations.

For yet another year, Appco Group Hellas supported “Pedtrauma” by offering our Charity € 0,50 on every item sold of their product “DryShine”.

On Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup> 2019, a presentation on “Education on Trauma Prevention” was held by Pedtrauma at the 99<sup>th</sup> Primary School of Athens as part of the “Open Schools” program which was organized by the Municipality of Athens and implemented with the founding donor Stavros Niarchos Foundation, the coordination of the Athens Partnership and the events’ promoter John S. Latsis Public Benefit Foundation. The purpose of the presentation was to inform parents on how to prevent children’s accidents from occurring both inside and outside the house.

On Tuesday, April 9<sup>th</sup> 2019, the Paediatric Department of the General Hospital of Kilkis was inaugurated. The Paediatric Department was renovated by the Charity “Pedtrauma” with funding provided by “Norton Rose Fulbright Greece”. The Department is now housed in a separate wing of the Hospital, offering a safe and welcoming hospital environment for young patients.

For the 6<sup>th</sup> consecutive year, we organized an Easter lottery, which was a great success. The Easter lottery draw was held at our offices on Tuesday April 16<sup>th</sup> 2019.

On Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup> the Chairman and CEO of the OTE Group, Mr Michael Tsamaz and the President of “Pedtrauma”, Mrs Natasha Clive-Vrecossis, visited the General Hospital of Chania “St. George” and the General Hospital of Rethymno to see the equipment which was donated to the Paediatric departments of these two Hospitals with funding provided by the OTE Group.

On Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup> the Chairman and CEO of the OTE Group, Mr Michael Tsamaz and Mrs Natasha Clive-Vrecossis, President of “Pedtrauma”, visited the Paediatric Trauma Center of the University General Hospital “ATTIKON”, which was renovated and equipped thanks to a donation to our Charity by the OTE Group.

On Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2019, Pediatric Trauma Care took part in the 16<sup>th</sup> Volunteering Festival which was held in Athens (Syntagma Square). The visitors had the opportunity to learn about our organization and the various projects we are currently working on, and to receive our booklets on Trauma Prevention.

Pedtrauma participated in the 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Capital Link CSR Forum “Investments, Extroversion & Social Responsibility. Pillars for Sustainable Development”, which was held at the Athens HILTON HOTEL, on Tuesday, June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The company “MEGA DISPOSABLES S.A.” supported our Charity, by offering medical equipment to the new Dermatology Unit of the 1<sup>st</sup> Paediatric Clinic of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens in the “Aghia Sophia” Children’s Hospital. The event to raise money took place from 19<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> September and was held at all the “GALAXIAS” stores for the purchase of “Babyfino Sensitive” and “BabyCare” products on offer.

On Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> & Monday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2019, Pedtrauma took part in the “Voluntary Action Festival 2019”, which was held in Gazi (Palio Amaksostasio O.S.Y. Aghias Triadas) by Skywalker.gr. The visitors talked to our volunteers and learned about our work, and also received our brochures on Trauma Prevention.



## AWARDS

For the 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive year, “Pedtrauma” was awarded a prize at the **Healthcare Business Awards 2019**, organized by Boussias Communications and Health Daily. This year our Charity was presented with the **GOLD** award in the category “Health offerings by Non-Governmental Organizations” for the Creation of Paediatric Trauma Centers and the purchasing of Equipment for the Paediatric Departments of Hospitals and Health Centers. The awards ceremony was held on Wednesday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> 2019, at the Multiplex Lolou in Paiania.

“Pedtrauma” participated in the “**THALIS II Mapping & Evaluation of the Non Profit Organizations in Greece**” program, run by the Political Science and International Relations Department of the University of the Peloponnese and the Non-Profit Organization HIGGS in collaboration with researchers from 3 universities, and was funded by the Charitable Foundations: TIMA Charitable Foundation, Stavros Niarchos Foundation, Athanasios K. Laskaridis Foundation, Captain Vassilis and Carmen Constantakopoulos Foundation and John S. Latsis Public Benefit Foundation. A total of 107 organizations completed the evaluation process of the program, selecting the fields of activity corresponding to their work. Our Charity was evaluated in two fields of activity (Education and Health), **receiving 4 stars** in both fields, which was the highest score awarded to NGO’s who participated in the program. In particular, only 9 NGOs (out of 42) received 4 stars in the “Health” field and only 12 NGOs (out of 51) received 4 stars in the “Education” field.

PUBLICATIONS – INTERVIEWS

On November 1<sup>st</sup> 2018, Pedtrauma's President, Mrs Natasha Clive-Vrecossis, presented the Charity's work and projects to Emi Livaniou and the Huffington Post Greece.

On December 10<sup>th</sup> 2018, Mrs Natasha-Clive-Vrecossis was interviewed on the website "Dinamitis Prosforas" about the work and goals of "Pedtrauma".

On February 11<sup>th</sup> 2019, Mrs Natasha Clive-Vrecossis spoke to Ilias Papanikolaou about the Charity's projects on Star Web TV's "LEADERS" show.

For yet another year, we had the opportunity to talk on radio shows about various topics concerning the Prevention of Children's Accidents. Through these interviews, we were able to inform and raise public awareness on the important subject of children's safety, and also to inform the public about our Charity's work.
