MEDICAL SEMINARS (“Leonidas Georgopoulos” Program)

(Cost: € 20.000,00)

Thanks to the sponsorship of an Anonymous Donor (donation of € 18.000,00) and the “Friends of Pediatric Trauma Care” (donation of € 2.000,00), we funded **7 A.P.L.S. (Advanced Paediatric Life Support) and P.L.S. (Paediatric Life Support) seminars** this year, which were attended by **183 doctors and nurses** in total. In November 2022, March, and May 2023 three A.P.L.S. seminars were held in Athens and Thessaloniki, in collaboration with A.P.L.S. Hellas. In Crete (Rethymno, Herakleion, and Agios Nikolaos), three P.L.S. seminars and one A.P.L.S. seminar were held in November and December 2022, and in September 2023, in collaboration with A.P.L.S. Crete. Total value of funding: € 20.000,00.



During these seminars, doctors, nurses, and Ambulance Paramedics are trained by experts in how to treat an injured child the fastest and best way possible. The training centers around the assessment, resuscitation, and stabilization of the condition of the child at risk.

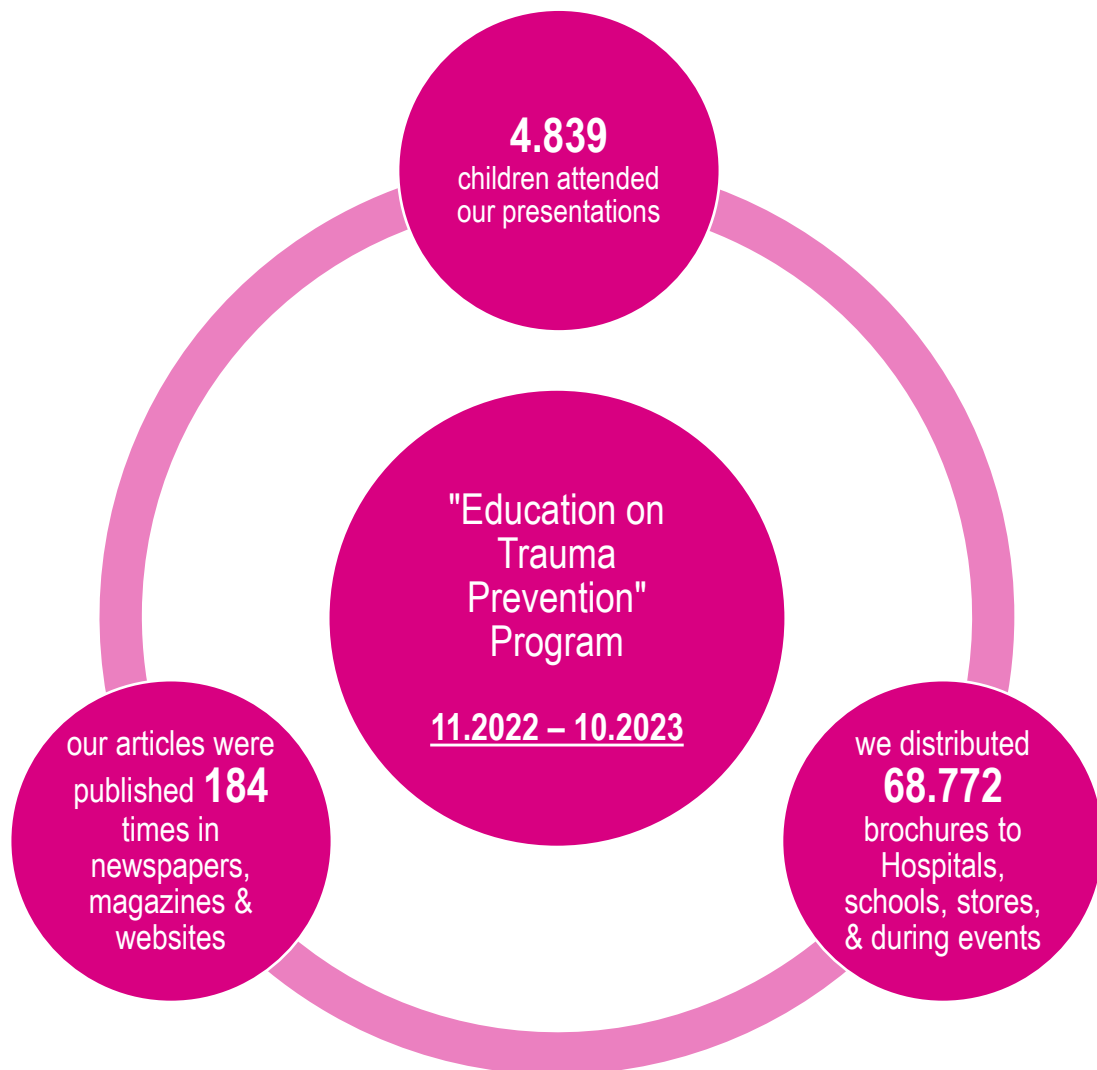

EDUCATION ON TRAUMA PREVENTION

(Cost: € 49.000,00)

It has been proven that educating children about the dangers they might face can significantly reduce the number and severity of paediatric accidents that occur. For this reason, we continued our presentations on Trauma Prevention and distributed educational brochures to Hospitals, Kindergartens and Primary Schools. To date, we have spoken to 57.587 children and 3.508 teachers and parents.



This year the sponsorship of the "Education on Trauma Prevention" Program was covered by the company BEIERSDORF HELLAS S.A. (donation of € 40.000,00).



From November 1st 2022 to October 31st 2023 we held 186 presentations in Kindergartens and Elementary Schools, which were attended by 4.839 children and 297 parents and teachers. A few presentations were held online while the rest took place in person.



Our brochures are distributed to Schools, Kindergartens and Parent Associations after the presentations on Trauma Prevention organized by our Charity, in order to inform children and parents and raise awareness on accidents. They are also distributed during events (bazaars, volunteerism festivals, CSR conferences, etc.) and we send them to Schools, Kindergartens and Hospitals throughout Greece.

During the course of the year, the MYTILINEOS company sponsored the printing of 20.000 brochures on “Safety at School”, 20.000 brochures on “Summer Holidays and Safety Measures”, and 20.000 brochures on “Respect the Animals”, at a cost of € 9.000,00.

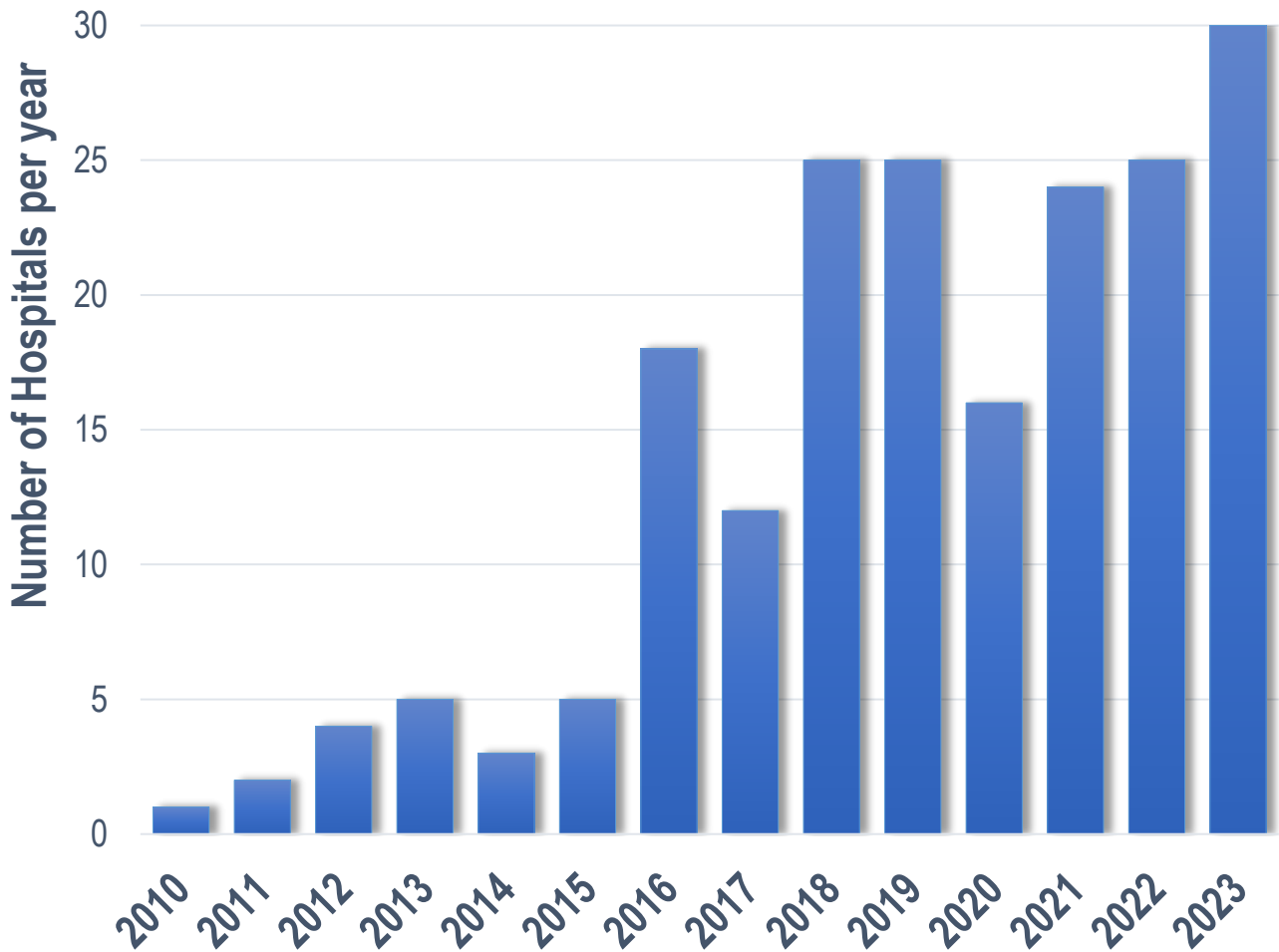


Finally, we continued to send brochures to the Hospitals and Health Centers we have equipped, in order to inform the parents visiting the Hospitals. So far, we have distributed more than 64.650 brochures to 112 Hospitals and Health Centers.

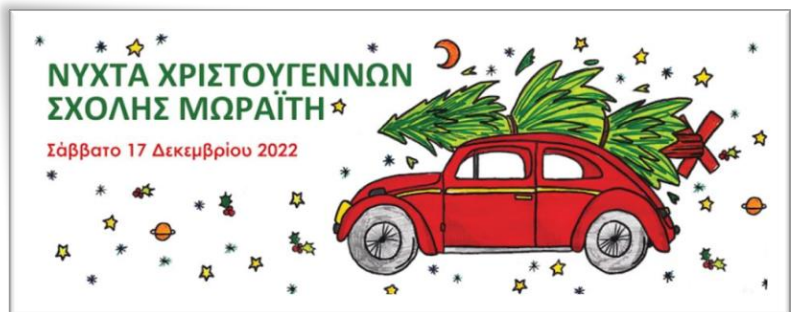

The company HELLENiQ ENERGY supported our Charity for yet another year by offering heating oil. This donation helped us cover part of our operating costs and continue our work.

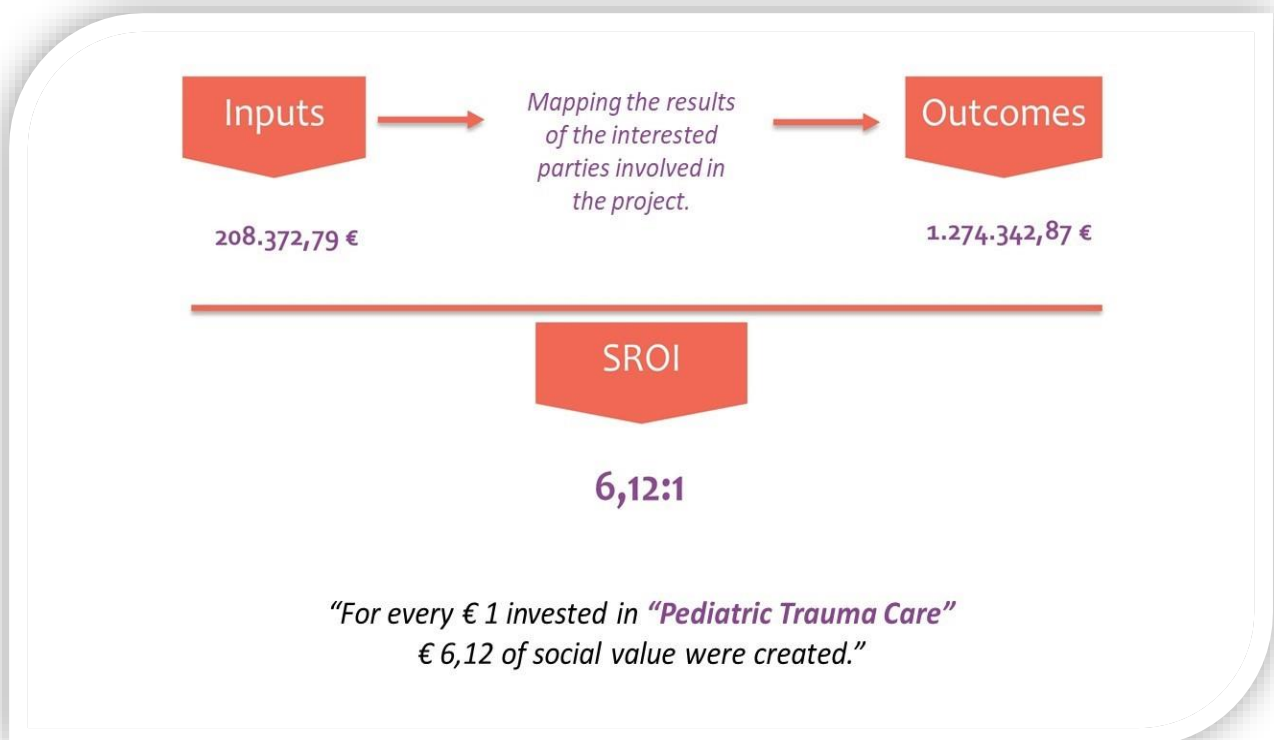

SOCIAL IMPACT STUDY

In 2023, the MYTILINEOS company funded the analysis of the social impact of its donations to our Charity during the period 2018 - 2022. These donations went towards the provision of paediatric equipment to 16 Hospitals and the printing of 6 educational brochures with advice on trauma prevention. The study was undertaken by the scientific team of Social Value Greece of Equal Society, while the analysis was based on the Social Return on Investment (SROI) methodology.

The study showed that the total investment of € 208.000 produced more than € 1,2 million in social value. More specifically, it was calculated that **€ 6,12 of social value was created for every € 1 invested.**

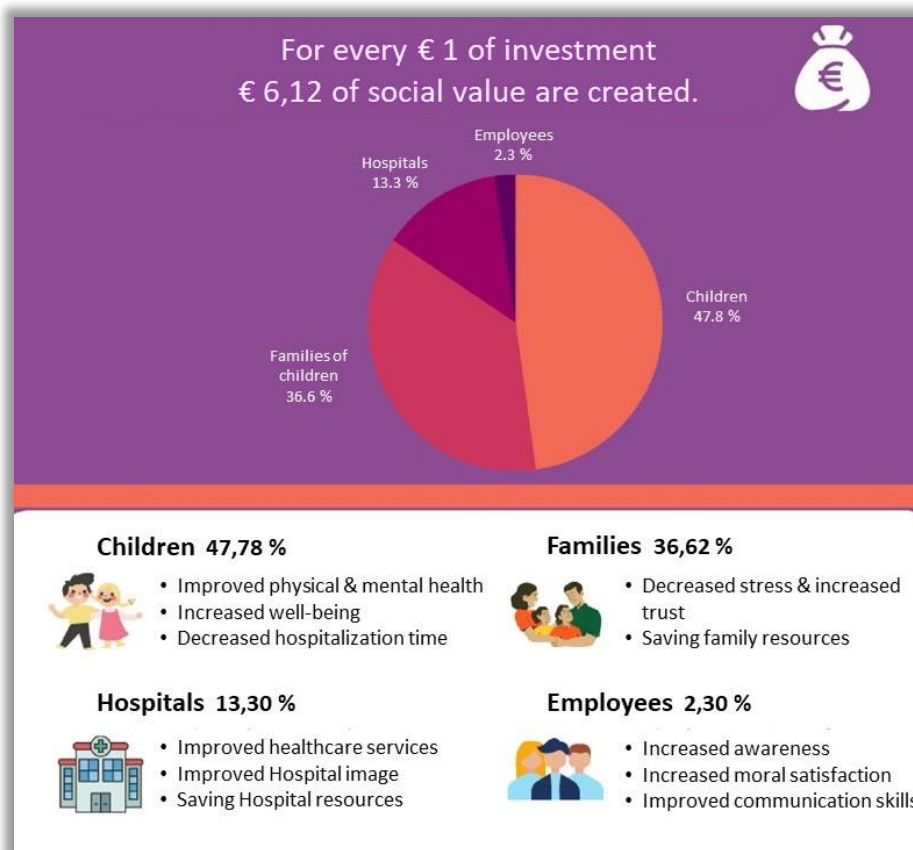


The SROI methodology narrates the story of the changes experienced by all those involved ("Theory of Change"), taking into account qualitative, quantitative, and financial data. It

also assigns monetary value to outcomes such as optimism, well-being, etc., thereby helping to create a comprehensive picture of the social value generated by the project.

This particular analysis drew information from our Charity, from publications and study of the international literature, as well as discussions with administrative and medical staff from the Hospitals.

It was found that "parents and children experience exclusively positive social and financial changes in their lives, which are related to improved mental and physical health, increased well-being, saving resources, improved family relationships, and other significant changes for each involved party."



AWARDS



On April 22nd 2023 Professor Christina Kanaka-Gantenbein, Director of the 1st Paediatric Department of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens in “Aghia Sophia” Children’s Hospital, and the Members of the 1st Paediatric Department, gave our Charity an honorary plaque for our contribution to the Department’s work over the years. The ceremony took place at the Dimitris Mitropoulos Hall – Megaron Athens International Conference Centre during the 56th Annual Therapeutic Meeting and the honorary plaque was received by “Pedtrauma”’s President Mrs Natasha Clive-Vrecossis.




In October 2023, “Pediatric Trauma Care” took part in the Bravo Sustainability Dialogue & Awards 2023 with the initiative “Upgrading of the Paediatric Departments of the Hospitals and Health Centers of Greece” in the Bravo Society category. BRAVO is an institution of social dialogue promoting Sustainable Development, developed on a national level, highlighting initiatives implemented by Businesses, Local Government Organizations and Civil Society. Throughout October, the Civic Society, with more than 20.000 Active Citizens, had the opportunity to vote for the initiatives they wished to highlight. On the 13th of November 2023, we were informed that, thanks to the votes we received and through the process of evaluation by the Institution's Committees, our Charity's initiative was distinguished at the Bravo Sustainability Dialogue & Awards 2023.

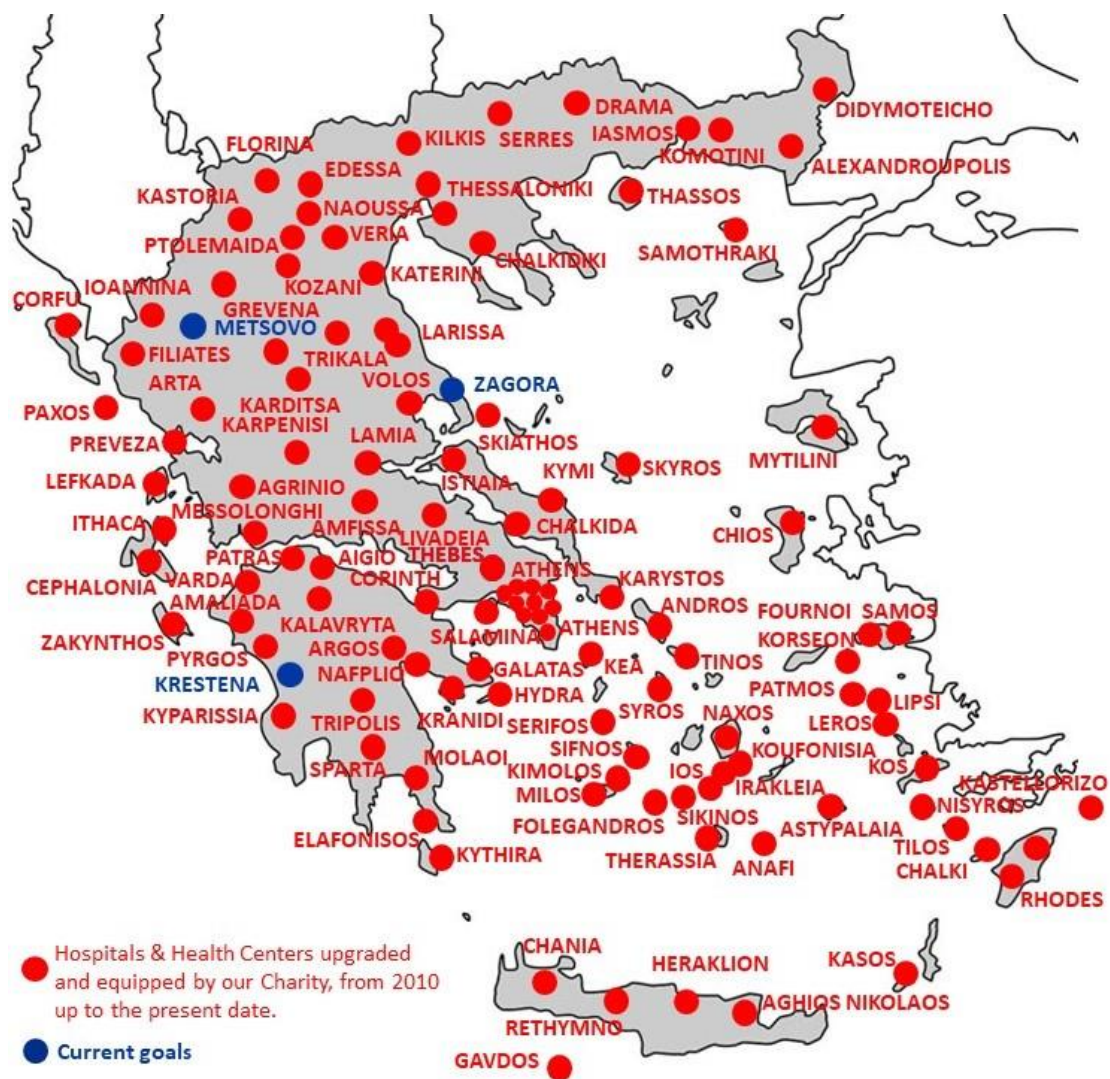


