# "DEFIBRILLATORS SAVE LIVES" PROGRAM

Recognizing the importance of immediate access to automated external defibrillators (AEDs) and responding to the numerous requests we have received from Schools and Cultural Associations for the donation of these critical devices, our Charity has launched a new program this year called "Defibrillators Save Lives".

Defibrillators are machines of vital importance, designed to assist individuals who have suffered cardiac arrest. They are small, portable devices that can deliver electric shocks to the heart, restoring its normal rhythm. Cardiac arrest is one of the most serious emergency situations,

as it can occur at any moment and lead to death within minutes if immediate intervention does not take place.

AEDs are specifically designed to be easy to use by non-specialized individuals, providing guided voice instructions for each step of the process, allowing even ordinary citizens to save lives.



The "Defibrillators Save Lives" Program aims to expand access to automated external defibrillators in even more public spaces, schools, cultural associations, and sports centres, making defibrillators an accessible tool in every community in order to save as many lives as possible.



#### **MEDICAL SEMINARS**

# ("Leonidas Georgopoulos" Program)

(Cost: € 26.000,00)

This year we funded **7 A.P.L.S.** (Advanced Paediatric Life Support) and P.L.S. (Paediatric Life Support) seminars, thanks to the sponsorship of two Anonymous Donors, where a total of **156 doctors and nurses** were trained. In collaboration with A.P.L.S. Hellas, three A.P.L.S. seminars were held in Athens and Thessaloniki, while two A.P.L.S. and two P.L.S. seminars were held in Crete (Heraklion, Chania, and Sitia), in collaboration with A.P.L.S. Crete.

During these seminars, doctors, nurses, and Ambulance Paramedics are trained by experts in how to treat an injured child the fastest and best way possible. The training centers around the assessment, resuscitation, and stabilization of the condition of the child at risk.





Since 2000, 2.254 doctors, nurses, and Ambulance Paramedics have been trained.

# **EDUCATION ON TRAUMA PREVENTION**

(Cost: € 61.000,00)

It has been proven that educating children about the dangers they might face can significantly reduce the number and severity of paediatric accidents that occur. For this reason, we continued our presentations on Trauma Prevention and distributed educational brochures to Hospitals, Kindergardens and Primary Schools. To date, we have spoken to 63.065 children and 3.508 teachers and parents.

From November 1st, 2023 to October 31st, 2024 we held 203 presentations in Kindergardens and Elementary Schools, which were attended by 5.478 children, more than in any other year since the beginning of the Program. A few presentations were held online while the rest took place in person.










In order to enhance the understanding and participation of children, at the end of the presentations, we distribute worksheets to be completed later and discussed in class by the teachers. The games are divided into three categories, according to the children's ages/grades: "Draw and Remember" for Kindergarden, "Snakes and Ladders" for the first grades of Elementary School, and "Crossword Puzzle" for the last grades of Elementary School.

During the course of the year, the company Metlen Energy & Metals S.A. (formerly MYTILINEOS S.A.) sponsored the printing of the brochures "Safety at Home", "Toys and Safety", "Safety at Sports", and "Prevention of Burns", as well as the folders used to distribute the brochures, with a total value of € 18.000.



Our brochures are distributed to Schools, Kindergardens, Nurseries and Parent Associations as well as during seminars and events (bazaars, volunteerism festivals, CSR conferences, etc.), to educate and raise awareness among children and parents. They are also distributed to the Hospitals and Health Centres that our Charity has upgraded and equipped, in order to inform visitors.




























# **COLLABORATION WITH THE "JOBSLINK" PLATFORM**

Through this collaboration, we had the opportunity to support a young woman on the autism spectrum who began volunteering at our Charity.

From the very beginning, it was evident that her past experiences had impacted her self-confidence, making her initially hesitant about her ability to integrate into the job market. However, with the guidance and support provided by our Charity, she was able to develop professional skills and build her self-confidence in a safe and encouraging environment. This experience, combined with the reference letter we provided her, was key to helping her find a full-time job.

This story is yet another testament to the value of volunteering and the importance of offering young people the support they need to grow both personally and professionally.


