

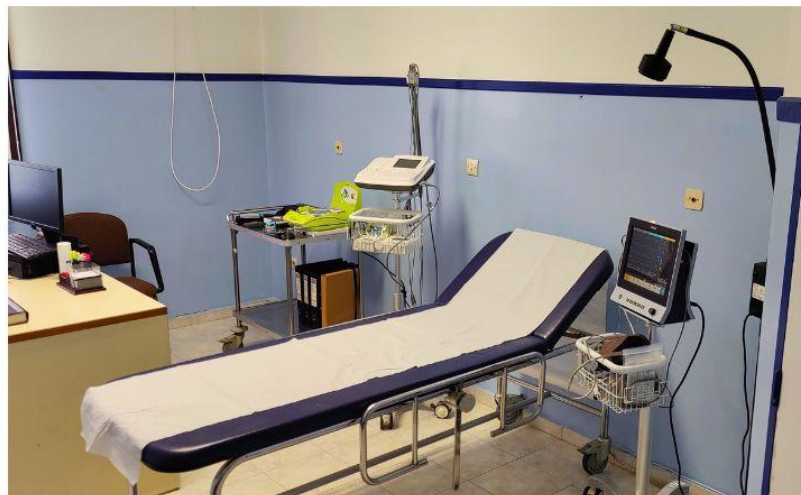

## MEDICAL SEMINARS

### “Leonidas Georgopoulos” Program

(Cost: € 26.000,00)

This year we funded **9 A.P.L.S. (Advanced Paediatric Life Support) and P.L.S. (Paediatric Life Support) seminars**, thanks to the sponsorship of two Anonymous Donors, where a total of **200 doctors and nurses** were trained. In collaboration with A.P.L.S. Hellas, four A.P.L.S. seminars were held in Athens and Thessaloniki, while four P.L.S. seminars and one A.P.L.S. seminar were held in Crete and Alexandroupolis, in collaboration with A.P.L.S. Crete.

During these seminars, doctors, nurses, and Ambulance Paramedics are trained by experts in how to treat an injured child the fastest and best way possible. The training centers around the assessment, resuscitation, and stabilization of the condition of the child at risk.



In addition to funding the seminars, the Charity also purchases necessary equipment for the training of participants. This year, with the support of an Anonymous Donor, we provided necessary training equipment for the seminars organised by A.P.L.S. Crete, at a total value of € 2.510,00.

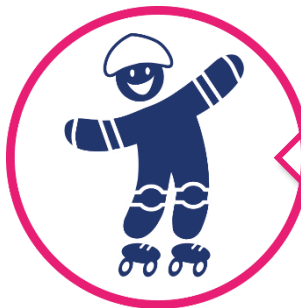

## EDUCATION ON TRAUMA PREVENTION

(Cost: € 49.000,00)

It has been proven that educating children about the dangers they might face can significantly reduce the number and severity of paediatric accidents that occur. For this reason, we continued our presentations on Trauma Prevention and distributed educational brochures to Hospitals, Kindergardens and Primary Schools. To date, we have spoken to 68.412 children and 3.618 teachers and parents.

For yet another year, the company Beiersdorf Hellas S.A. sponsored the "Education on Trauma Prevention" Program (donation of € 43.000,00).



From November 1st, 2024 to October 31st, 2025 we held 192 presentations in Kindergardens and Elementary Schools, which were attended by 5.347 children. A few presentations were held online while the rest took place in person.



During the course of the year, the company METLEN Energy & Metals S.A. sponsored the printing of the brochures "Swimming Saves Lives" and "Safety at the Playground", with a total value of € 6.000,00.



Our brochures are distributed to Schools, Kindergardens, Nurseries and Parent Associations as well as during seminars and events (bazaars, volunteerism festivals, CSR conferences, etc.), to educate and raise awareness among children and parents. They are also distributed to the Hospitals and Health Centres that our Charity has upgraded and equipped, in order to inform visitors.

## EVENTS

### NOVEMBER 2024

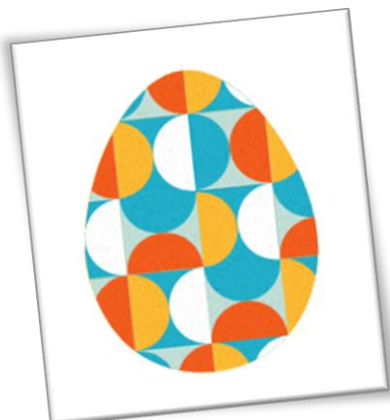
cooperation, and gratitude.

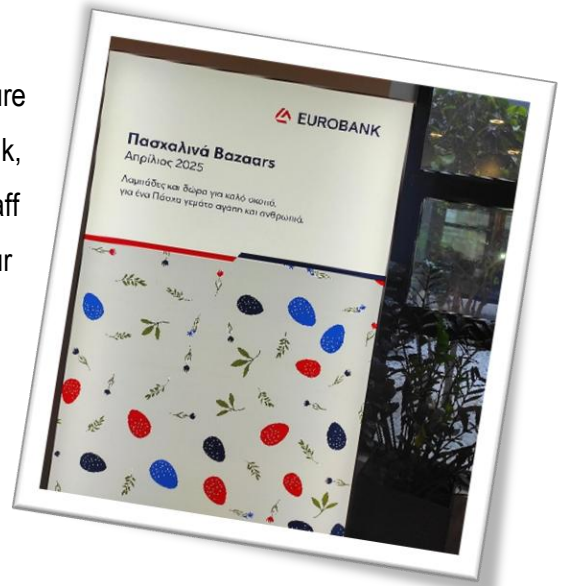
## APRIL 2025

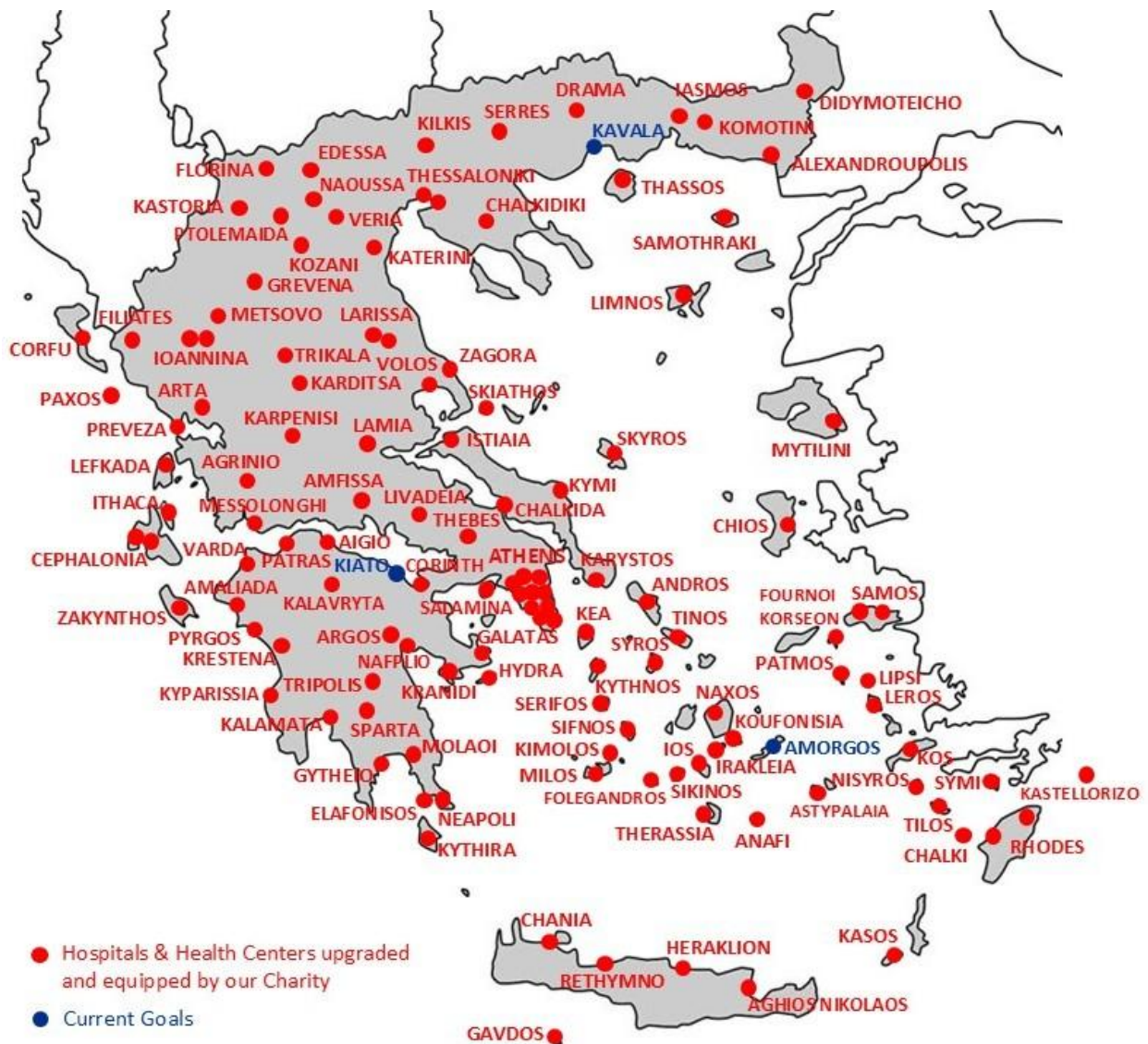


